Thanks for sharing in worship service with us! We are excited you're here and hope you feel comfortable.

Here's some information we thought you might want to know:

RESTROOMS are located at the end of the hall to the right and left of the foyer.

Parents w/infants please feel free to use the TLC ROOM, located across the hall from "GOD'S BIG BACKYARD". The TLC ROOM has a sink, changing table and some privacy for nursing mothers.

CHILD CARE (birth to 3 years) is available during both the 8:15 a.m. and 10:45a.m. hours from our "GOD'S BIG BACKYARD" staff. You will find the "GOD'S BIG BACKYARD" check-in desk to your right as you enter the building.
